Please be advised that Wisconsin Statute Sec. 7.06(2) provides you the opportunity to appoint a substitute for me and my deputy if I feel it is in the county's best interest for someone else to run the board of canvassers in the event of a April 5, 2011 election recount. In addition to my being aware of this statute, Kevin Kennedy of the Government Accountability Board reminded me of the appropriateness of this method under the current circumstances.

I believe that there are those who, through innuendo or erroneous facts, would imply that the election in Waukesha County was not fairly run and I believe this is wrong. But I do believe that the citizens of Waukesha County would be best served and there would be a total avoidance of any appearance of impropriety or conflict if an independent third party were appointed by you to run the board of canvassers for a recount in the April 2011 Supreme Court election.
